



### Categories:

\* **I category** – students of I, II, and III grade of elementary music school (six year of schooling), students of I and II grade of elementary music school (four year of schooling), students of I grade of elementary music school (two year of schooling).

\* **II category** – students of IV, V and VI grade of elementary music school (six year of schooling), students of III and IV grade of elementary music school (four year of schooling), students of II grade of elementary music school (two year of schooling).

\* **III category** – students of I and II grade of secondary (high) music school

\* **IV category** – students of III and IV grade of secondary (high) music school

\* **V category** – students of bachelor studies

\* **VI category** – students of master and doctoral studies (up to 35 years old)

**Programme and duration:**

\* **I category** – free choice of compositions up to 5 minutes

\* **II category** - free choice of compositions up to 10 minutes

\* **III category** – At least two compositions of free choice of different styles and characters up to 15 minutes

\* **IV category** – At least two compositions of free choice of different styles and characters up to 20 minutes

\* **V category** – At least two compositions of different stylistic epochs and characters up to 25 minutes (one composition must be originally written for registered ensemble)

\* **VI category** – At least two compositions of different stylistic epochs and characters up to 30 minutes (one composition must be originally written for registered ensemble)

With application contestants must prepare copies of compositions to be performed.
